Author, broadcaster and acclaimed historian, Professor John Foot will explore Italy's tumultuous history from 1945 to the present day. Combining research with lively insights, he will recount the riveting story of a country marked by scandal but with the constant ability to reinvent itself. He will outline the crises and modernisations of post-war Italy, from its fields and factories to the political intrigue of Rome. His talk will appeal to history buffs and holiday-makers alike.

Dr John Foot is Professor of Modern Italian History at Bristol University. He has written histories of Italian football and Italian cycling. More recently he has written "The Archipelago: Italy since 1945", published by Bloomsbury.
