## THE GLAMOUR OF ITALIAN FASHION 1945-2014

An illustrated talk by curator Lucia Savi

**Wednesday, 17th February 2021 at 7.30pm**

Lucia's talk is based on what was the V&A Museum's first major exhibition to explore Italy's rich contribution to modern fashion from the end of the Second World War to the present. Lucia will examine the expertise for which Italy has become renowned, from haute couture to ready-to-wear accessories. She will also discuss contributions from the leading Italian fashion houses, including Dolce and Gabbana, Armani, Gucci and Versace.

Dr Lucia Savi is a curator and fashion historian specialising in twentieth-century textiles, fashion and design with a focus on Italy. In 2019, Lucia was awarded her PhD from Kingston University, London with her thesis entitled: 'The Relationship between Italy's Textile and Fashion Production, 1945-1985'. She has more than 10 years' experience in curating, publishing and lecturing. Lucia has worked as Research Assistant both at the Victoria and Albert Museum and the Courtauld Gallery
